

Brewery Licences – Guidelines and Application

A Brewery licence may be issued to a person or company licensed under the laws of Canada to produce beer.

If you are interested in establishing a Brewery in Newfoundland and Labrador please use the following as a **guideline** of the requirements. *Please note: other agencies or departments may require information further to that which is listed below.*

Completed application for a brewery licence (see attached) Please note if you intend to include a 'tap room' on your premises, you will require a Lounge Licence (separate application).		
Completed Personal Data Sheets (enclosed) for all shareholders or directors		
Current Certificate of Conduct for all Directors		
Written Municipal approval		
Written approval from the Provincial Fire Commissioner's Office		
• One set of floor plans, drawn to scale on paper no larger than 8.5" x 14", outlining the proposed licensed area, including dimensions of clearly identified rooms (including storage)		
A current signed copy of a lease or purchase agreement		
• If incorporated, please provide Notice of Directors form, <i>The Corporations Act</i> (Form 6)		
Written approval from the Canada Revenue Agency (see CRA section below)		
• Verification of Food Establishment Licence (see Government Modernization and Service Delivery section below)		
Written approval from Buildings Accessibility and Fire & Life Safety (see Government Modernization and Service Delivery section below)		
Once all information is collected, a pre-licensing inspection will be conducted		

NLC Product Approvals and Reporting

- As you move through the process, it is important for you to consult with NLC's Merchandising Department, which is responsible for the products approved and sold by breweries. - Product pricing is based on NLC's pricing policy. A fixed and variable markup component is applied to your cost which is the NLC markup. If approved, you may be eligible for a microbrewery discount as per the policy. For more information on pricing, please contact Alicia Clarke at (709) 724-1221 or alicia.clarke@nlliquor.com.
- Brewery Licensees will be required to file a monthly commission report to the NLC
 which tracks your inventory, production and sales and will detail the amount of
 commission due to the NLC. Commission due to NLC must be paid monthly in
 accordance with policy. Licensed breweries are also subject to audits by the NLC.



Other Agency Requirements - Brewery Licence

Canada Revenue Agency (CRA)

CRA issues the licence to produce alcohol in Canada and will assist with any production questions you may have. For more information, please call 1-888-327-7999.

Government Modernization and Service Delivery

To operate a brewery, a Food Establishment Licence is required. Government Modernization and Service Delivery conducts health inspections at all food establishments in the province, including breweries. For more information, please call (709) 729-2104.

The proposed brewery will also need approvals for Building Accessibility and Fire and Life Safety. For more information, please call (709) 729-1038.
